Our **Program Support Services team** connects families to vital resources—from housing and healthcare to food and education—helping youth and their Bigs flourish in strong, stable mentoring relationships.

Family Resource Specialists like Diana Hernandez step in when families need it most—responding to more than 500 referral requests in FY25, 70% of them emergencies—to ensure youth stay on track to reach their potential. Meanwhile, Christina Sundermeier., our College & Career Resource

Specialist, guided **300 students** to the resources, coaching, and opportunities that prepare them for long-term success. Together with our mentors and **Program and Enrollment/Match Specialists**, our Program Support Services team removes barriers and opens doors that transform futures.


